Dear Shoreline Grade Eight Families,

It's time to start thinking about High School! Please read the following information carefully.

As you may know, Shoreline Middle School belongs to the Esquimalt Family of Schools. Our Grade eight children automatically transfer to Esquimalt High School.

If you would like to send your child to a school other than Esquimalt High, you must apply for transfer during the K - 12 Student Transfer Process taking place between Feb. 11 and Feb. 19, 2016. The transfer forms will be available at all schools starting Feb. 11. They will also be posted on the District website www.sd61.bc.ca.

The following steps are necessary to transfer to another school:

- o Completion of the K-12 Student Transfer Application form, including date and signature.
- o Parents mail or deliver the completed K-12 Student Transfer Application form to the School Board Office by Friday, February 19, 2016.
- o Transfer applications are reviewed with school space in mind, and families receive an approval or denial letter by the end of March 2016. When transfers have been approved, students will be considered members of the new Family of Schools.

After February 19, 2016, elementary and middle school students wishing to attend a school other than their designated pathway school are asked to go to the school they wish to attend to have their name placed on a wait list.
