Students will be canoeing with students and staff from their learning group.

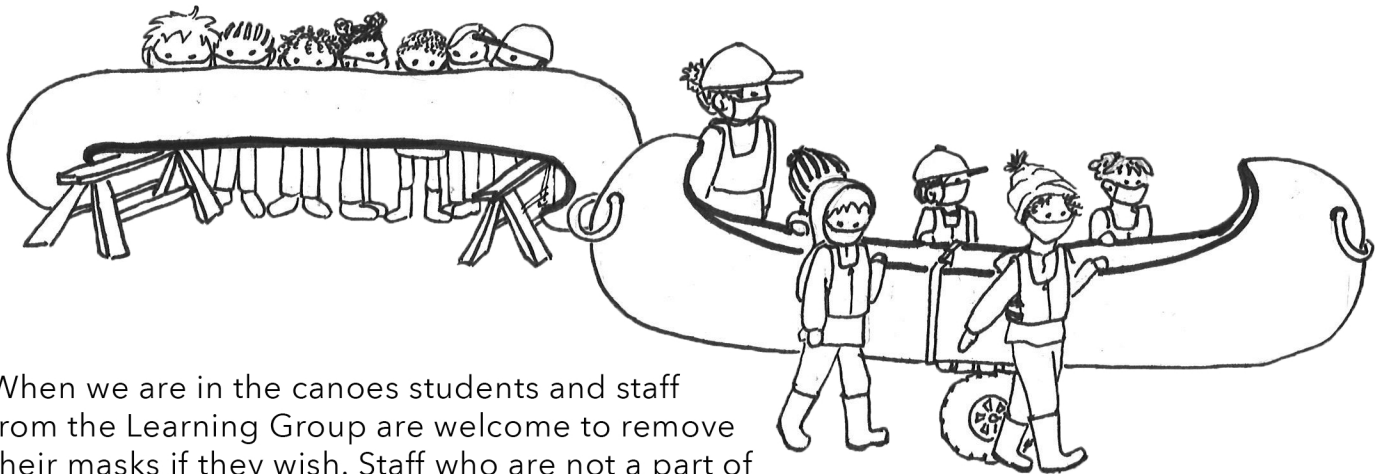

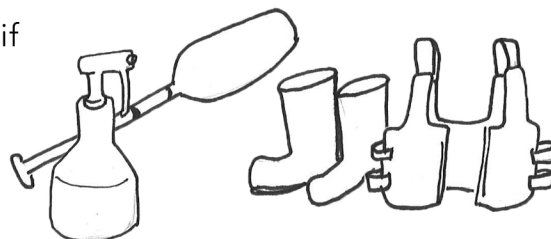
Hand Sanitizer will be carried in the canoes and used by all before and after any eating.

On the picnic days we will stop for lunch at parks with bathrooms where hands can be washed or sanitized before and after eating.

Students will be asked not to snack in the canoes without sanitizing their hands properly. Any hot chocolate will be made by staff following proper protocols at the school and served in clean mugs that are touched only by staff with sanitized hands. Students will sanitize their hands before accepting their mug. Food and drink will not be shared.



All equipment will be sprayed with sanitizer if possible and left for four days untouched in between canoe days.
