**Administration Update** (Gautam/Micha)

- Updated Health and Safety Guidelines
  - Covid cases increasing
  - Masks now required at all times
  - Change for staff/students, no longer able to take masks off when seated at desks with some exceptions
  - Students doing very well so far
  - Office is no longer having to give out masks at the previous rate
  - Increased cleaning/sanitizing is ongoing
  
- New stairs
  - Currently being built
  - Students have been doing a good job of staying away from work area
  
- Student led conferences

  - Early dismissal
  - Due to covid it will be navigated at home by students - more information to be provided
  
- Grade 8 Celebration(s)
  - Not going to be able to be definitive about what can be done until it is clear what is possible given Covid context.
  - Making plans, but need to be flexible as we do not know what restrictions will be in place.

- Student learning survey
  - Information went home this week
  - Grade 7 - Parents/students
  - Informs practice for school/district as well as provincial view of what is going on
  - Helps to inform school goals
  - Identifies target areas a regarding school needs
  - Informs school priorities
  
- Disc Golf:
  - Baskets have been delivered
  - Awaiting District communications regarding installation
  - Final funding sources/requirements still under review
  
- Big Canoe program - Ongoing
  - Went out this week
  - Working on teaching skills about safety on water as well as other skills.
  
- Transitions Gr 5/Gr 8
  - Hoping to start visiting schools depending on Covid limitations
  - Looking at providing supports to make transitions successful
  
- Next year
  - Will need to transition one of the computer rooms to a classroom to accommodate new students.
  - Expecting ~350-360 students total next year
  
- 2021/2022 Budget
  - Thought exchange link for provided today for input on budgeting process
  - Important that parents provide input to budgeting process
  - \$7 million District deficit going into next year
  - Will require items to be trimmed
  - Parents/Admin need to identify items that are valued, and provide input.
  
- Grade 8 Gift
  - Discussion regarding options for Grade 8 gift
  - Feedback from students has been mixed on what they would want
  - Consider experience
