 - Remembrance Day – assembly at school.
 - Looking for new learning spaces within the school, work around creating new classroom in the cafeteria, also needing breakout room for emerging learners, considering converting one of the change rooms.
 - Looking at options for outdoor spaces. Created another basketball court as well as four-square on black-top. Fields are very well used during recess and lunch time, football, soccer, rugby, volleyball, etc.
 - Rugby Academy has started during block 5 Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays. It is open to all students regardless of level. Requires teacher and parent permission.
 - Basketball has started, currently 3 teams.
 - FSA assessments in progress (Gr. 7s).

- Island Sexual Health visits in classrooms continuing.
- Big Canoe program is up and running. Wednesdays and Fridays, classes should each get 2 to 3 opportunities through the year.
- Music programs are up and running.
- Humble Hooves – Equine Assisted Learning running, funded by private donor.
- YFC – looking at opportunities for Christmas season.
- Place based field trip – Township of View Royal in conjunction with new transit centre being built - November 1, classes going out to do community tree planting.
- Many other things currently going on in the school.
